1. **Novice Hunter:** Cross Rails. Novice horse or rider, trot or canter.
2. **Hunter over Fences:** 2'3"
3. **Working Hunter:** 2'6"
4. **Knock Down and Out:** \$100 winner takes all! **Sponsor: Melissa Ann Dowd, Attorney-at-Law**
5. **Open Showmanship:** All ages.

LUNCH BREAK – 30 minutes

6. **Tot Leadline:** Children 10 and under. No payback. Entry fee: \$10. May cross-enter in classes 7, 24 & 28.
7. **Beginner Youth:** All tack. Ages 12 and under. Walk only. May cross-enter in classes 6, 24 & 28.
8. **Junior Rider Horsemanship:** All tack. Ages 14 and under. Walk and trot/jog/pleasure gait.
9. **Gaited All Day English Style:** Walk and pleasure gait.
10. **Gaited All Day Western Style:** Walk and pleasure gait.
11. **All Day English:** Walk and trot.
12. **All Day Western:** Walk and jog.
13. **Cloverleaf Barrels:** Open. **Belt Buckle sponsor: Tom, Tommy & Savannah Hevener**
14. **Ribbon Race:** Open. One entry fee/two ribbons/one money.
15. **Speed Barrel:** Open. Single barrel. **Sponsor: Little Big Dog Rescue**
16. **Open Non-Gaited Go as You Please:** Walk and trot/jog.
17. **Open Gaited Go as You Please:** Walk and pleasure gait.
18. **Open Western Pleasure:** Walk, jog and lope.
19. **Hunt Seat Pleasure:** Walk, trot and canter.
20. **4-H, FFA or Pony Club All Day:** All tack. Walk and trot/jog/pleasure gait. **Sponsor: Sullystone Stables**
21. ***Highland Residents Only* All Day:** All tack. Walk and trot/jog/pleasure gait.
22. **Open Pair:** All tack. Walk and trot/jog, pleasure gait. Two ribbons, one money.
23. **Family Class:** All tack. Two or more members of one family. One entry, one ribbon, one money.
24. **Young People's Horsemanship Western:** Ages 18 and under. Walk, jog and lope.
Rebel Trophy: Dorothy and Crysta Stephenson
25. **Young People's Horsemanship English:** Ages 18 and under. Walk, trot/pleasure gait and canter.
Pebble's Trophy: Bobbie Hefner
26. ***NEW THIS YEAR* Break N Out:** All tack. Walk, pleasure gait/jog/trot, canter/lope and other commands such as halt, back up, etc. at the judge's discretion.
27. **Costume:** Horses may be ridden or led, with or without a rider. **Sponsor: Highland County SPCA**

Open Accounts: A signed check must be left at registration.

Entry scratch day of show: must cancel 2 classes before their class or forfeit the entry fee.

Schooling in the Ring: Saturday morning 8 - 9:30 AM.

Age: Based upon rider's age on day of show.

Fences classes: All equines permitted. ASTM/SEI hard helmets required.

Knock Down and Out: Single Fence. Knock down or refusal results in elimination. After each round, the fence will be raised. Equines and/or riders may only enter once. Highest clear jump wins. Starting height 2'6". Tie broken by jump-off.

Games classes: Horses must enter and exit the ring at a walk and are open to all types of horses, riders and tack.

Horse Show Committee: The Horse Show Committee reserves the right to combine or cancel any/all classes.

Equines, exhibitors, and/or visitors engaged in inappropriate behavior as determined by the Horse Show Committee will be excused from the ring and fairgrounds.

Exhibitors are responsible for only entering classes suited to themselves and their mounts.

Horses are not permitted on the carnival grounds.

Gaited horses are welcome in over fences classes.

No alcohol is permitted on the fairground's property.

Dogs must be on leash and remain in the parking area.

Helmets: ASTM/SEI hard helmets are encouraged for all mounted riders and are mandatory in beginner classes, ages 18 and under riders, and over fences/jumping classes.

Coggins: Copy of current (12) months negative Coggins test must be submitted in advance with entries.

Equine Activity Liability Waiver: must be signed by all participants and/or guardians.

Assumption of Risk: All participants and spectators assume the inherent risk of injury associated with equine activities while on the fairgrounds.

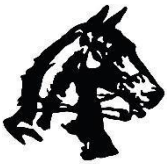
Judges' decision is final. All entries shall conform to the Federal Horse Protection Act.

DIRECTIONS From the South: Enter the Town of Monterey on US 220; fairgrounds located just north of Jerry's Electronics (429 Jackson River Rd/US 220, Monterey, VA); entrance on the right (E) side of US 220, Jackson River Rd.

From the East: Enter the Town of Monterey on US 250; turn left (S) onto US 220, Jackson River Rd, and proceed .4 m; fairgrounds entrance on the left (E) side of US 220, Jackson River Rd.

From the West: Enter the Town of Monterey on US 250; turn right (S) onto US 220, and proceed .4 m; fairgrounds entrance on the left (E) side of US 220, Jackson River Rd.

From the North: Enter the Town of Monterey on US 220; proceed south on US 220, Jackson River Rd, .4 m south of the intersection of US Routes 220 and 250; fairgrounds entrance on the left (E) side of US 220, Jackson River Rd.
