General Information

Share what your organization has accomplished over the last year with an educational, informative exhibit. Exhibits are to be entered in the Gym. Exhibits should be no wider than the size of a standard tri-board poster (48 inches). Additional props (flyers, handouts, examples of project work, giveaways etc.) are welcome as part of the exhibit as long as they are contained within the size limits. Exhibits should showcase and/or teach observers about your topic; this is not a business or product ad space. Exhibits judged on the Danish System of Blue, Red and White awards. Can be more than one blue award per category. A Judges Choice Poster may be chosen from all four categories, which includes additional prize money.

Class:

1. Exhibits by 4-H membership in Highland County (4-H Community Clubs, In-School 4-H Enrichment, 4-H Camping, Junior Master Gardener/School Garden, etc.)
2. Exhibits by FFA membership in Highland County (FFA Chapters, FFA Officers, FFA Contests/Winners etc.)
3. Exhibits by Boy Scout or Girl Scout Troops in Highland County
4. Exhibits by Other Youth Organizations or School Clubs (Youth Philanthropy Council, Homeschool Groups, School Classes/Projects/Field Trips, School Clubs – Radio Club, International Club, Out of Time, Game Club, etc.)
5. Exhibits by Churches and/or Religious Groups in Highland County (Outreach/Mission, church youth groups, Food Pantries & Drives, vacation bible school, bible study, etc.)
6. Educational/Informative Exhibit by a Business
7. Exhibits by any other group in Highland County not specified in classes 1-6.
