Adult (19 and older)

Guidelines:

- A. Exhibits for adults, ages 19 and over.
- B. Exhibits will be judged on: general appearance, workmanship and techniques, harmony or contrast of color selection, and appropriateness of selected materials balanced
- C. Any item made by a person with a disability that they wish to disclose, can enter the appropriate category for the item. A star will be placed on the front of the item tag to let the judges know to take this into consideration when judging.
- D. Any item made from a kit must be identified as such.
- E. Even though exhibits are mostly judged on their own merits, enhancements of an exhibit achieved through special mountings, framing, or display may be considered.
- F. In this age division, there will be one "Best in Show" ribbon plus \$10.00 awarded and one "Runner-up Best in Show" ribbon plus \$5.00 awarded.
