1. **Open Showmanship:** All ages.
2. **Tot Leadline:** Children 10 and under. No payback. Entry fee: \$10. May cross-enter in classes 1, 3, 10, 19, 26.
3. **Beginner Youth:** All tack. Ages 12 and under. Walk only. May cross-enter in classes 1, 2, 10, 19, 26.

4. **Novice Hunter over Fences (jumping):** Cross Rails. Novice horse or rider, trot or canter.
5. **Hunter over Fences (jumping):** 2'3"
6. **Handy Hunter over Fences (jumping):** 2'6" **Prize Sponsor: Meaghan Ryder, 1st & 2nd place.**
7. **Knock Down and Out over Fences (jumping):** Starts at 2'9", fences raised until highest clear jump wins. \$100 & blue ribbon - winner takes all! **Sponsor: Melissa Ann Dowd, Attorney-at-Law**

8. **Cloverleaf Barrels (speed):** Open.
9. **Speed Barrel (speed):** Open. Single barrel. **Sponsor: Little Big Dog Rescue**
10. **Costume:** Horses may be ridden or led, with or without a rider.

11. **Open Gaited Go as You Please:** Walk and pleasure gait.
12. **Gaited All Day Western Style:** Walk and pleasure gait.
13. **Junior Rider Horsemanship:** All tack. Ages 14 and under. Walk and trot/jog/pleasure gait.
14. **4-H, FFA or Pony Club All Day:** All tack. Walk and trot/jog/pleasure gait. **Sponsor: Sullystone Stables**
15. **Open Junior All Day:** All tack. Ages 18 and under. Walk and trot/jog/pleasure gait.
16. **Open Hunt Seat Pleasure:** Walk, trot and canter.
17. **All Day English:** Walk and trot.
18. **Young People's English Equitation:** Ages 18 and under. Walk, trot, pleasure gait and canter.

19. **Mini Equine Showmanship:** Open to all mini equines.

20. **Open Non-Gaited Go as You Please:** Walk and trot/jog.
21. **All Day Western:** Walk and jog. **Sponsor: Dare to Dream Therapeutic Horsemanship Center**
22. **Open Western Pleasure:** Walk, jog and lope.
23. **Young People's Horsemanship Western:** Ages 18 and under. Walk, jog and lope (no gaited horses).
Rebel Trophy: Dorothy and Crysta Stephenson
24. ***Highland Residents Only* All Day:** All tack. Walk and trot/jog/pleasure gait.
25. **Open Pair:** All tack. Walk and trot/jog/pleasure gait. One entry, two ribbons, one money.
26. **Family Class:** All tack. Walk and trot/jog/pleasure gait. Two or more members of one family. One entry, ribbon & money.
27. **Break N Out/Command:** All tack. Walk, pleasure gait/jog/trot, canter/lope and other commands such as halt, back up, etc. at the judge's discretion.



Payment: A signed check must be left at registration for open accounts. \$35 fee for returned checks. **Entry scratch day of show** must cancel 2 classes before their class or forfeit the entry fee. **Tack changes between classes:** Four minutes. **Classes with only 1 entry:** will receive 2nd place prize money. **Schooling in the Ring:** 6:50-7:20: lunging only; 7:20-7:40: rail work only; 7:45-8:05: jumping (2'3"-2'6") & rail work; 8:05-8:25: jumping (cross rails) & rail work. **Age:** Based upon rider's age on day of show. **Jumping classes (4-7):** All breeds permitted, ASTM/SEI hard helmets required. **Dogs** must be on leash and remain in the parking area. **Speed classes (8 & 9):** Horses must enter and exit the ring at a walk, classes are open to all breeds of horses, riders, and tack. **The Horse Show Committee** reserves the right to combine or cancel any/all classes. **Equines, exhibitors, and/or visitors** engaged in inappropriate behavior as determined by the Horse Show Committee will be excused from the ring and fairgrounds. **Exhibitors** are responsible for only entering classes suited to themselves and their mounts. Horses are not permitted on the carnival grounds. **No alcohol** is permitted on the fairground's property. **Manure** must be cleared/removed from trailer parking area. **Helmets:** ASTM/SEI hard helmets are encouraged for all mounted riders and are mandatory in beginner classes, ages 18 & under riders, and over fences/jumping classes. **Coggins:** Copy of current (12) months negative Coggins test must be submitted in advance with entries, and will be checked at the gate. **Rider numbers** will be provided by the show – use of personal numbers is prohibited. **Equine Activity Liability Waiver** must be signed by all participants and/or guardians. **Assumption of Risk:** All participants and spectators assume the inherent risk of injury associated with equine activities while on the fairgrounds. **Saddles** must be used in all classes except costume.

Judges' decision is final.

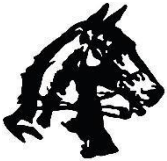
DIRECTIONS

From the South: Enter the Town of Monterey on US 220; fairgrounds located just north of Jerry's Electronics (429 Jackson River Rd/US 220, Monterey, VA); entrance on the right (E) side of US 220, Jackson River Rd.

From the East: Enter the Town of Monterey on US 250; turn left (S) onto US 220, Jackson River Rd, and proceed *** 0.4 m; fairgrounds entrance on the left (E) side of US 220, Jackson River Rd.

From the West: Enter the Town of Monterey on US 250; turn right (S) onto US 220, *** and proceed as above.

From the North: Enter the Town of Monterey on US 220; proceed South on US 220, Jackson River Rd, *** “
