When entering group classes (Family Class, Pairs Class, Costume Class) we ask that you only submit one entry and only use the number connected to that entry because it will be the only name we have on file the day of the show. We will be checking back numbers at the gate and entrants will be required to wear the number connected to the person that entered to join the class. IF you are wearing the incorrect back number we WILL NOT have you listed on the class list per our records

## General Rules:

- A signed check **must** be left at registration for open accounts
- \$35 fee for returned checks
- Must scratch or add classes **2** classes before originally entered/scheduled class or forfeit entry fee
- Tack changes between classes are **four** minutes, please notify in-gate when you have a tack change or special circumstances
- People showing more than one horse **must** complete separate entry forms for each horse. One form for **each** horse/rider combination, no exceptions
- Riders under the age of **16 must** have an adult accompany them to the registration table in order to make changes to their classes
- The **age** of exhibitors is based on age on the day of the show
- **Jumping Classes**(4-7)all breeds, and all riders are **required** to wear an ASTM/SEI-approved helmet in these classes
- **Speed Classes**(9 & 10)all breeds and all tack are permitted, and horses **must** enter and exit the ring at a **walk**
- Rail Classes with **over 20** entries will be split
- **Walk/jog, Walk/trot, Walk/pleasure gait Classes**(11-15, 17-18, 21, 22, 26-28) Riders in these classes are **restricted** to these gaits. If their horse breaks into a canter or lope they may be excused from the ring
- ASTM/SEI-approved helmets are **required** for any riders 18 years and younger in **any class** and are encouraged for all riders over 18 years of age
- Back numbers will be provided by the show, use of personal numbers is **prohibited**
- Saddles **must** be used in all classes except costume
- Exhibitors are responsible for only entering classes suited for **themselves and their mounts**
- Manure **must** be cleared from trailer parking area
- Horses are not permitted on carnival grounds
- Dogs **must** remain on a leash and in the parking area
- **NO alcohol** is permitted on the fairground's property
- A **PAPER** copy of a current 12-month negative Coggins test is **required** upon entry to the fairgrounds and **will** be checked at the gate and again at the registration table. Coggins **must** be submitted in advance with online entries or early entry fee does **NOT** apply \*IF you entered online and provided your Coggins, you will not have to show it at the registration table-only at the gate
- **Equines, Exhibitors, and/or visitors engaged in inappropriate behavior determined by the Horse Show Committee will be excused from the ring and/or fairgrounds**
- All participants and/or guardians **must** sign the **Equine Liability Waiver** which adheres to the **Assumption of risk** that participants and spectators assume the inherent risk of injury associated with equine activities while on the fairgrounds
- The **Horse Show Committee** reserves the right to combine, split, or cancel any/all classes

Schooling in the Ring:

**Lunging Only:** 6:50-7:20

**Flat Work Only:** 7:20-7:40

**Jumping(2') & Rail Work:** 7:45-8:05

**Jumping(Cross Rails) & Rail Work:** 8:05-8:25
